Dear Parent:

We are concerned that our school age children have adequate dental care and dental health information.

For children whose parents are unable to provide private dental care, the Darien Board of Education (with the assistance of Darien dentists and the Darien Community Association) is prepared to offer this service for a nominal amount of the regular costs. The participating dentists of Darien have volunteered their services and private facilities to maintain the therapeutic dental health program. As in the past, it will be necessary to prove a definite financial need each school year to be eligible for dental services.

(If your son or daughter has any dental problems currently, please call the school nurse in your child's school.)
