EMERGENCY INFORMATION FOR CHILDREN WITH SPECIAL NEEDS


Several months ago the Darien Police Department met with some parents of the community whose children have special needs. During that meeting, parents expressed concerns as to how their child might respond to emergency personnel under a stressful/atypical incident. As a result of that meeting, there was a consensus among those in attendance that it might be beneficial if the responding agencies, i.e. Police, Fire, and E.M.S., have some basic information regarding the special needs of your child.

As a result, the Darien Police Department is accepting information about your child's special needs that will be maintained in a database and accessed when the need arises. Participation in the program is optional. Information provided by you will be used by emergency personnel only.

The emergency registration forms may be obtained in the office of your school or the front desk of the Police Department.
